Terrea Mitchell, Disability Justice and Rights Activist & Organizer of NY Peoples Power Assemblies (PPA)

TERREA MITCHELL is a Black, disabled, ace Disability Justice and Rights, and movement for Black Lives activist and organizer in NY Peoples Power Assemblies (PPA NYC). PPA has joined with CWA Local 1180 and other unions and disability groups at the Disability Pride Parade every year. Terrea's and PPA's advocacy for disabled people and others includes: mutual aid assistance such as in the current pandemic; accessibility in mass transportation, demanding more accessibility from the MTA and more elevators in the subways; ending police brutality and all violence against and killings of people with disabilities, which disproportonately impacts disabled people, Black, indigenous, people of color women and LGBTQ folks. PPA NYC is part of the movement for Black lives.
