


Aetna Medicare Advantage TOP 5 QUESTIONS

Do I have coverage if I move out of New York?

The Aetna Medicare Advantage PPO plan is a national plan and portable. The plan comes with you wherever you go/move within the U.S. or U.S. territories.

When will I receive my member ID card?

You will receive a new member ID card in the mail in August.

Do I need the 365-day hospital rider?

No, the Aetna Medicare Advantage PPO plan includes unlimited coverage for inpatient hospitalization.

I have pre-existing conditions. Will this plan cover my previous medical conditions?

Yes, there are no pre-existing medical clauses, and you will be covered by all Medicare benefits.

How much is the monthly pension deduction for the prescription drug rider?

Beginning Sept. 1, 2023, the monthly pension deduction is \$103.50. The premium will increase to \$135.50 in 2024.
