GUEST SPEAKER



Music industry insider **Maria A. Davis** was diagnosed with HIV in 1995 after unknowingly contracting the virus from her fiancé. In 2006, she founded Can't Be Silenced, Inc., a 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization to raise funds and provide services to those impacted by the epidemic.

She is currently a spokesperson and community coordinator for the National Black Leadership Commission on Health, Choose Healthy Life, and IRIS House. She served on NYC Mayor's HIV/AIDS Services Administration Advisory board from 2016-2024, and was a spokesperson for Bristol-Myers Squibb (PREVAIL), and Merck's I Design, a national campaign for HIV/AIDS education. She works closely with First Corinthian Baptist Church HIV/AIDS Health ministry, Ryan Healthcare, and Iris House to provide free HIV/AIDS testing education and outreach throughout the New York City area.
