Their advocacy spans community integration, educational rights, equal access to programs and services, and accessible housing. They use a wide range of advocacy tools, including community organizing, coalition-building, individual representation, impact litigation, and legislative advocacy. Ruth Lowenkron is the Director of the Disability Justice Program at NYLPI. Lowenkron has been active in the field of disability law since 1981, working at Untapped Resources, Inc. (NY), the Community Health Law Project (NJ), the Education Law Center (NJ), and Disability Rights New Jersey. She has assisted countless persons with physical, mental, and other disabilities via impact litigation, legislative advocacy, and community outreach. She is a NYS Special Education Independent Hearing Officer and an adjunct professor of disability law at Seton Hall Law School.
