

# 5 REFERENDUM QUESTIONS on the November Ballot

1.

## Amending the Apportionment and Redistricting Process

Purpose: Would freeze the number of state senators at 63 and amend the process for the counting of the state's population.

## Right To Clean Air, Clean Water, and a Healthful Environment

Purpose: Will give every New Yorker the constitutional right to clean air and water, and will provide the tools for government to make sure it happens.

## Eliminating Ten-Day-Advance Voter Registration Requirement

Purpose: Would remove the current requirement that citizens be registered to vote at least 10 days before an election, basically translating to same-day registration that is already permissible in many other states.

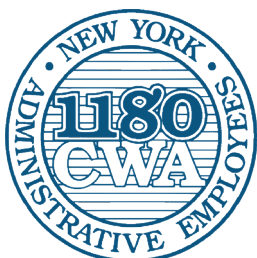
## Authorizing No-Excuse Absentee Ballot Voting

Purpose: Would remove the current provision on absentee ballots that requires voters to list a reason for requesting an absentee ballot, thus allowing New York to join 34 other states that already have no restriction absentee ballot voting.

## Independent Redistricting Changes

Purpose: Would increase the New York City Civil Court's jurisdiction by allowing it to hear and decide claims of up to \$50,000 instead of the current limit of \$25,000.
